

Guidelines for Eposter Presentations

General Guidelines for Creating ePosters:

1. It is recommended to design eposters using the following sections:
 - Title, author and address
 - Purpose
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
2. Keep text to a minimum, emphasise graphics, and make sure every item in the eposter is necessary. On the iPosterSessions platform you will be able to create an interactive multimedia eposter incorporating:
 - High resolution images
 - Slideshows
 - High definition videos
 - Narrations and other audio files
 - Links to external sites and data sets
 - Online communication tools
3. Eposters must correspond directly with the original abstract submitted.
4. Eposters must be written and presented in English.
5. The use of colour makes the eposter more effective and attractive. A neutral or grey colour as the background will be easier for the viewer than a bright colour. In addition, colour photos look best when mounted on grey.
6. A font size of at least 11pt is recommended to ensure the text is legible.

Publishing/Uploading the ePoster:

ePosters at the Latin American Epilepsy Congress will be displayed via the iPosterSessions platform. Each presenting author will be sent his/her unique **login credentials** for the platform by the Congress Secretariat.

ePosters must be published on the iPosterSessions platform by Monday 8th February. Publishing allows eposters to be tested for functionality. ePosters may be edited once they have been published, up to, **26th February**.
